ABOVE EMPLOYEE STATES WHILE SHE WAS IN THE BACK OF THE ABOVE BUSINESS GETTING READY TO START THE BUSINESS DAY, THE BELOW OFFENDERS CAME INTO THE OPEN DOOR (UNLOCKED) LEADING INTO THE EMPLOYEE AREA CONFRONTING HER GRABBING HER BY THE NECK WALKING HER TO THE BACK TELLING HER TO LEAD HIM TO THE SAFE SAYING WHERE IS THE SAFE WITH THE MONEY, ALL THE TIME HOLKING HER FROM THE BACK OF THE NECK AND STRIKING HER IN THE BACK OF THE HEAD AND RIGHT ARM WITH HIS HAND, EMPLOYEE DID OPEN THE SAFE AND OFFENDER TOOK THE MONEY WRAPPED IN A RUBBER BAND AND FLED OUT OF THE DOOR IN AN UNKNOWN DIRECTION.
